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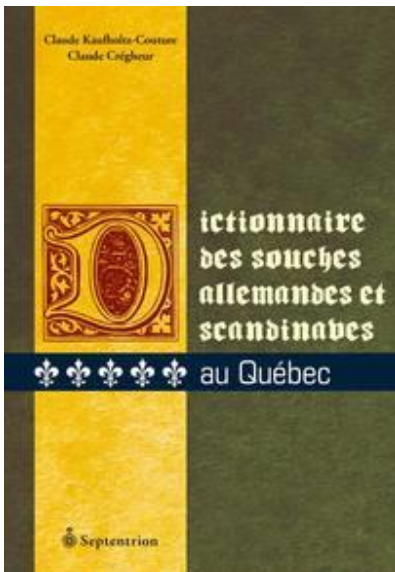

Although I have never set foot in Finland there is a part of me that maintains a deep connection to the country and its people. My paternal grandparents immigrated to the United States during the later part of the 19th century. They settled in the predominantly Finnish community of Ashtabula, Ohio. At that time the port city on Lake Erie thrived with many ore boats moving up and down the Great Lakes. Several relatives sought work on the docks.

My grandfather on the other hand was a blacksmith with four forges. Both he and my grandmother contributed to the community. He became a translator for newcomers. His wife, a member of the Ladies of Kaleva* rallied as a staunch advocate for the Temperance League.

Most dictionaries do not have a word in their language to describe the Finnish word "SISU". It is hard to define this deep-rooted characteristic among the Finnish people and the words that come to mind are: 'courageous' and 'determined' or simply put, they have 'guts' and go about living these characteristics in their daily lives.

Life has not been easy for the people of Finland. Over the centuries invasions were common. The country is situated between Sweden and Russia. During the Second World War the Finns fought against the Russians and in 1950 agreements were finally reached between the two countries when Finland finally gained independence, thanks to the ingenuity during the Second World War with the troops of camouflaged soldiers on skis.

Today, Finland is a thriving country. The education system is first class. Their health program is strong, and most people speak and understand English. It is a prerequisite for entrance to higher learning. To keep up internationally, the country realized the need for citizens to possess these language skills.

My father, being a Finn continued to maintain several Finnish traditions and the most important one we cherished growing up was our real traditional truly wood burning Finnish sauna. Most Finns build their saunas first and Dad maintained the custom. Before building our home, we had a sauna and many happy family gatherings took place down at the river where the sauna was located.

In 1953, she formed the AKA Furniture Company on Sherbrooke Street, which specialized in the design and construction of Scandinavian Modern furniture. Elias Friedlander – 1846-1927 – Rabbi with a birth at Kovno (Kaunas, Lithuania) who in 1884 was elected to the position of minister of the Congregation of English, German and Polish Jews of Montreal, one of the largest Jewish congregations in Montreal, which represented a moderate, acculturated traditionalism. Its members had great respect for religious customs and ceremonies within the synagogue but had largely adopted English Canadian norms in their personal lives. Two years later Friedlander officiated at the consecration of a new synagogue for the congregation, named Shaar Hashomayim. In 1887 he was a founding member of one of the first proto-Zionist societies in Canada, probably the Hovevei Zion Society of Montreal. It never flourished, however. He remained at Shaar Hashomayim until 1896, when he resigned because of differences with the congregation's trustees. > Biographi.ca

Jens Eriksen Munk (Munck) - 1579-1628 – Danish sailor, military officer who wintered at the mouth of the Churchill River in 1620. His pilots thought they were in Hudson Bay, but Munk was not sure. They were in Ungava Bay. After rectifying this mistake, they made no more navigational errors. With adverse winds it took six days to regain the strait, and Hudson Bay was entered near Digges Island. Munk called the whole of what is now known as Hudson Bay “Novum Mare Christian.” At this time only the southern portion was known as “Hudson's Bay”; the western part was called Button's Bay. Munk's account of the bay is the first to treat the inland sea, and his map the first on which the whole of the bay is depicted > Biographi.ca

Eiríkr Thorvaldsson (Eric the Red) – 985 – First European to explore and settle Greenland and in 985 he returned to Iceland, organized a colonization company, and led that year or the next a flotilla of 25 ships (14 of which reached their goal) to Greenland. These people formed the nucleus of the two Icelandic colonies, the Western and Eastern Settlements on the west coast of Greenland. The Western Settlement was deserted by its inhabitants c. 1340 but the Eastern Settlement endured into the 16th century. From these settlements the Icelanders made voyages north to the Canadian islands of the Arctic and south to the east coasts of Canada and the United States of America > Biographi.ca

emigrants to North America, replacing New York as the main destination, from 1850 until the late 1860s. During those years, 94 percent of Norwegian emigrants landed in Canada. After the repeal of British navigation laws in the mid-nineteenth century, Norwegian sailing ships engaged in the lucrative timber trade between Quebec City and the British Isles. Ships carried timber one way across the Atlantic and the emigrants on the way west. For the vast majority landing in Quebec port cities, Canada became a corridor to their final destinations in the Upper Midwest of the United States, primarily Wisconsin and Minnesota. Iceland - 1832 - **Icelandic Unitarians** - Unitarian Church of the Messiah - Beaver Hall Hill - Montréal - Rev. David Hughes from the Remonstrant Synod of Ulster in Northern Ireland, presiding - In 1843 a new church was erected on Beaver Hall Hill, Rev. John Corner, presiding from 1843 to 1878. In 1842 or 1843, immigrants from Iceland were church members at the Unitarian Church. In 1869, the church building was severely damaged by fire. Father Dowd, Pastor at St. Patrick's Cathedral, a friend of John Corner let him use St. Patrick Hall while renovations were carried out at the Unitarian Church of the Messiah. Norway -1855 & 1862 - **Norwegian Lutherans** - The Norwegian community of Montreal first worshipped at St. John's German Lutheran Church in Old Montreal - The Lutheran Church of Norway or the Scandinavian Missions or

Sailors Institute were organized in 1862. The church services were first held at the Y.M.C.A Building, located at the time on Dominion Square, church no longer exist - It does appear that this congregation would later become Our Saviour Lutheran Church in Lachine – BAnQ Vieux-Montréal microfilms (1855-1885 under St. Johns Lutheran) & (1885-1910 under Scandinavian Lutheran) & (1941 under Norwegian Seamen Lutheran) > BAnQ Vieux-Montréal

Sweden - 1863 - **Swedish Presbyterians** - New Jerusalem in the Revelation Presbyterian Swedenborgian - Montréal - Organized in 1863 at the corner of Dorchester Boulevard and Hannover Street in a building referred to as the Old High School, Rev. E. Gould, presiding in 1863. This congregation was most likely the first Swedish church in Montreal. Swedish New Jerusalem in the Revelation was also referred to as New Jerusalem Presbyterian or Swedenborgian Presbyterian - Church closed in 1905 or 1906 – BAnQ Vieux-Montréal microfilms (1863-1899 under New Jerusalem Presbyterian) & (1876-1882 under New Jerusalem Presbyterian) > BAnQ Vieux-Montréal

European Countries - 1868 - **European Presbyterians** - Presbyterian Mission - Old Montréal - In 1868, the Presbyterian Church opened a mission within the church building of the Lutheran Church of St-Dominique Street, the latter located near Charlotte Lane, across the street from the St. Lawrence Market - The Presbyterian Mission of St-Dominique Street was a preaching point of St. Paul Street Presbyterian, the

Montreal Emigrant Society 1832

The Montreal Emigrant Society was established in 1831. Its main purpose was to provide transportation for immigrants who had arrived at Montréal from Québec and were destined for settlement in different parts of Lower Canada (Quebec) and Upper Canada (Ontario).

From 1831 to 1835, the Montreal Emigrant Society provided relief to 49,740 immigrants. In 1832, 10,244 immigrants were given relief and 8,763 received assistance to settle. Return of the poor and destitute emigrants forwarded and relieved by the Montreal Emigrant Society from 23rd May 1832 to 1st November 1832.

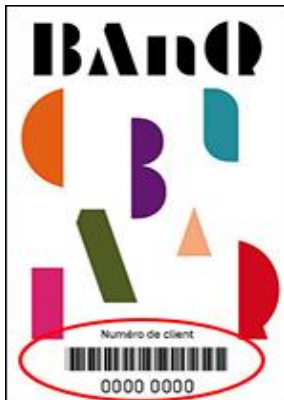

It allows patrons to use all services, collections and equipment offered on-site at the Grande Bibliothèque, at BANQ Rosemont–La Petite-Patrie and at the ten (10) BANQ Archives (Archives nationales du Québec) across the Province of Québec.



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The card provides access to numerous services relating to borrowing materials, and to other on-site and online services.
