Guide to Court Records

Guide to Court Records, Evelyn Kolish, 2017, 99 p. [PDF - 1.16 Mo]

BAnQ has close to 21 kilometres of court records in its 10 centres, dating back to the middle of the 17th century. These records constitute an historical archival fonds of remarkable depth and continuity, that enables researchers to study how Québec society has changed from its origins to the present day.

Created by courts throughout Québec, these records are preserved in the BAnQ regional centre closest to their point of origin. Because they show how different aspects of daily life have changed, both over time and by region, they can give sometimes highly detailed information about the past. This information can provide many different paths of inquiry: into specific people and events, as well as into broader social, economic, and political phenomena – not to mention the judicial system itself!

The Guide to Court Records will give researchers an overview of how the courts themselves and the records they create have changed over the past four centuries. Furthermore, for practical purposes, the Guide is based specifically on the court records preserved in BAnQ's regional centres.

BAnQ conserve près de 21 kilomètres d'archives judiciaires dans ses 10 centres. Ces archives remontent jusqu'au milieu du XVII^e siècle. Elles forment un ensemble de fonds d'une profondeur historique et d'une continuité remarquable permettant aux chercheurs de suivre l'évolution de la société québécoise depuis son début jusqu'à nos jours.

Produites par des tribunaux disséminés dans toutes les régions du Québec, ces archives sont également conservées près de leur lieu de création, dans les centres régionaux de BAnQ. Elles constituent donc une source qui témoigne non seulement de l'évolution historique de nombreux phénomènes mais aussi de la diversité régionale. Ouvrant une fenêtre parfois fort détaillée sur le passé, ces

archives proposent des pistes de recherche des plus variées, tant sur des individus ou des événements en particulier que sur des phénomènes sociaux, économiques et politiques, sans parler du fonctionnement du système judiciaire lui-même.

Le Guide des archives judiciaires permettra aux chercheurs d'avoir une vue d'ensemble sur l'évolution des tribunaux et sur leur production documentaire depuis quatre siècles. Enfin, du point de vue pratique, il a été conçu en fonction des archives judiciaires conservées dans chacun des centres régionaux de BAnQ. La consultation du fichier PDF requiert Acrobat Reader.

**Between the Ancien Régime and Liberal Modernity:
Law, Justice, and State Formation in Colonial
Quebec, 1760-1867**

The author surveys the historiography of state formation in colonial Quebec, from British Conquest of 1759-1760 to Confederation in 1867, focussing on law and justice. He structures his survey around three key themes: the Conquest as a point of rupture, with the imposition of a British colonial state and English law on top of a largely French-origin society; the nature of the Ancien-régime state over the 80 years that followed; and the historiographical debate over the creation of a new liberal order in Quebec from the 1840s onwards.

L'auteur passe en revue l'historiographie de la formation de l'État dans le Québec colonial, de la conquête britannique de 1759-1760 à la Confédération de 1867, en se concentrant sur le droit et la justice. Il structure son enquête autour de trois thèmes principaux : la Conquête comme point de rupture, avec l'imposition d'un État colonial britannique et d'un droit anglais au-dessus d'une société majoritairement d'origine française ; la nature de l'État d'Ancien régime au cours des 80 années qui

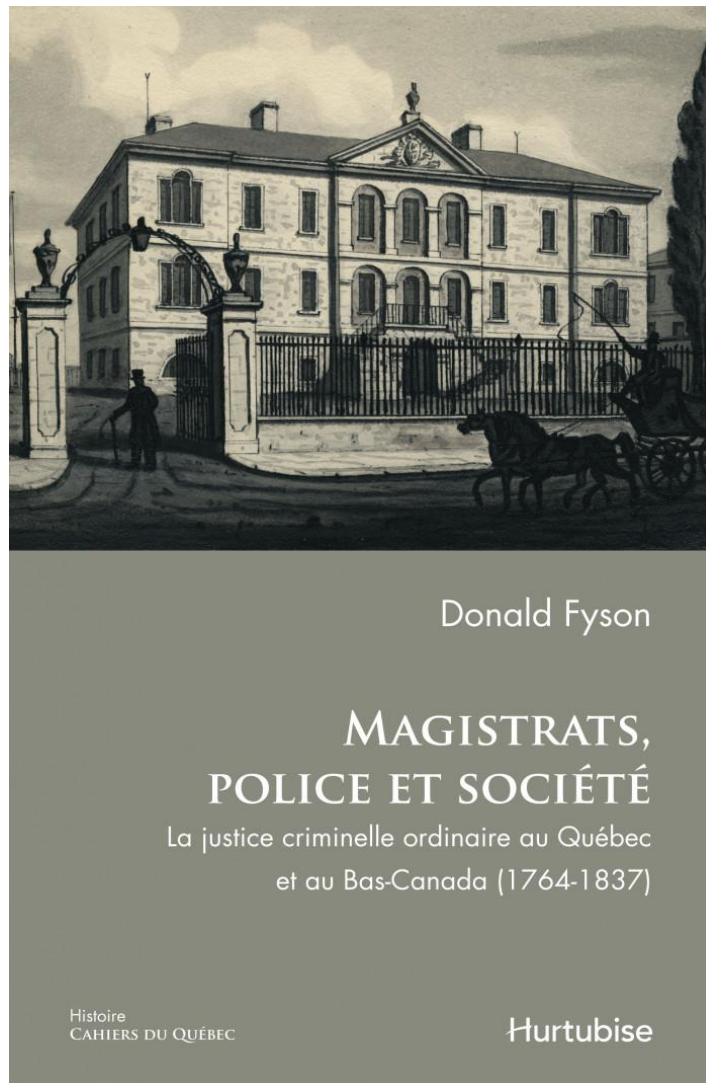
suivirent ; et le débat historiographique sur la création d'un nouvel ordre libéral au Québec à partir des années 1840.

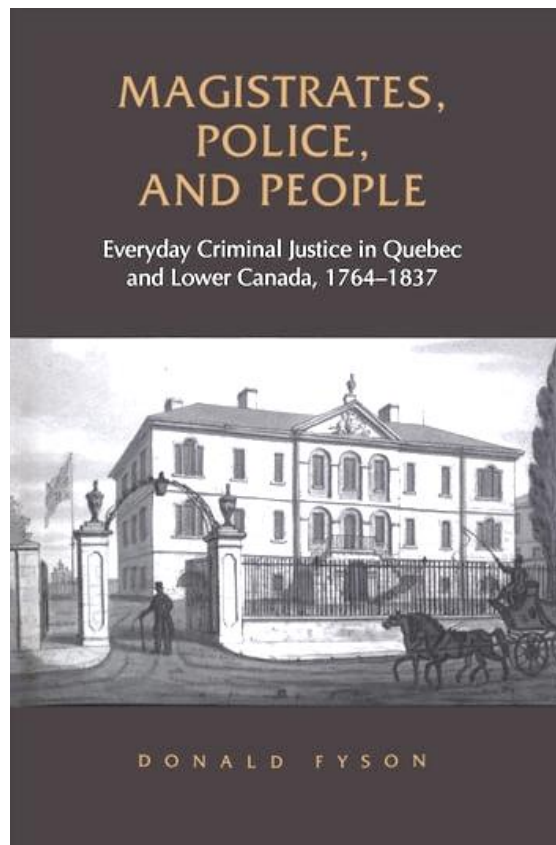

The place of criminal justice in a conquered colony is always problematic. Quebec is no exception, with many historians suggesting that between the Conquest and the Rebellions, the colony's *Canadien* inhabitants both boycotted and were excluded from the British criminal justice system. This book challenges that simplistic view of the relationship between criminal law and Quebec society. Based on extensive research in judicial and official sources, it offers the first comprehensive study of the everyday workings of criminal justice in Quebec and Lower Canada. Focussing on the justices of the peace and their police, Fyson examines both the criminal justice system itself and the system in operation, as experienced by those who came in contact with it. He takes issue with many received interpretations, such as the profound effects of the Conquest: in practice, criminal justice changed little, in the definition of offences or the nature of the system. Conversely, in the decades from the 1760s to the 1830s, criminal law and justice were transformed, responding to the social and economic changes that swept the colony and to the desires of local elites, both *Canadien* and British. The

magistracy and the police, made up of men from both ethno-cultural groups, became increasingly extensive and professionalized, in a modernization often ascribed to the period following the Rebellions. The relationship between the people and the system also changed dramatically. This is best exemplified by the steady rise in prosecutions: from being relatively marginal, criminal justice became increasingly familiar to both *Canadiens* and British in the colony, especially in urban areas. Though the system was significantly biased, its flexibility provided a source of power for ordinary citizens. At the same time, everyday criminal justice offered the colonial state and colonial elites a powerful though often faulty means to impose themselves on Quebec society.

La place de la justice pénale dans une colonie conquise est toujours problématique. Le Québec ne fait pas exception, de nombreux historiens suggérant qu'entre la Conquête et les Rébellions, les habitants canadiens de la colonie ont à la fois boycotté et été exclus du système de justice pénale britannique. Cet ouvrage remet en question cette vision simpliste du rapport entre le droit pénal et la société québécoise. S'appuyant sur des recherches approfondies dans les sources judiciaires et officielles, il propose la première étude exhaustive du fonctionnement quotidien de la justice pénale au Québec et au Bas-Canada. En se concentrant sur les juges de paix et leur police, Fyson examine à la fois le système de justice pénale lui-même et le système en place, tel que vécu par ceux qui sont entrés en contact avec lui. Il conteste de nombreuses interprétations reçues, comme les effets profonds de la Conquête : en pratique, la justice pénale a peu changé, dans la définition des délits ou la nature du système. À l'inverse, dans les décennies des années 1760 aux années 1830, le droit pénal et la justice se transforment, répondant aux changements sociaux et économiques qui balayent la colonie et aux désirs des élites locales, tant canadiennes qu'anglaises. La magistrature et la police, composées d'hommes des deux groupes ethnoculturels, se sont de plus en plus étendues et professionnalisées, dans une modernisation souvent attribuée à la période suivant les Rébellions. La relation entre les gens et le système a également changé de façon spectaculaire. La meilleure illustration en est l'augmentation constante des poursuites : de relativement marginale, la justice pénale est devenue de plus en plus familière aux Canadiens et aux Britanniques de la colonie, surtout dans les zones urbaines. Bien que le système ait été considérablement biaisé, sa flexibilité a fourni une source de pouvoir aux citoyens ordinaires. En même temps, la justice pénale quotidienne offrait à l'État colonial et aux élites coloniales un moyen puissant, mais souvent défectueux, de s'imposer à la société québécoise.

Index des dossiers de la Cour d'appel pour le Bas-Canada 1772-1835

Les appels durant le Régime anglais jusqu'en 1849

À l'origine, le gouvernement anglais veut doter sa nouvelle colonie d'une administration de la justice simple et calquée sur les structures anglaises. De 1764 à 1774, le gouverneur et son conseil forment la cour d'appel. Suivent la Cour d'appel provisoire en 1776, la Cour d'appel en 1777 puis la Cour d'appel provinciale ou Cour supérieure de juridiction civile à partir de 1793 et jusqu'en 1843. Le tribunal siège alors uniquement à Québec. La Cour d'appel provinciale est abrogée en 1843 et remplacée la même année par la Cour d'appel pour le Bas-Canada (7 Vict., c. 18) qui a juridiction sur les causes civiles et criminelles. Désormais, trois sessions seront tenues alternativement à Québec et à Montréal. Les cours d'appel de cette époque entendent principalement des litiges civils dont les montants en cause excédaient 10 livres sterling (de 1777 à 1792) ou 20 livres sterling (de 1793 à 1849). Peu de causes criminelles s'y trouvent, car aucun droit d'appel automatique n'existait en droit criminel à l'époque.

Entre 1764 et 1849, les cours d'appel constituent le tribunal final d'appel pour toutes les causes civiles et criminelles du Bas-Canada sauf possibilité d'appel devant le comité judiciaire du Conseil privé à Londres pour les causes supérieures à 500 louis.

La base de données Index des dossiers de la Cour d'appel pour le Bas-Canada, 1772-1835 (BAnQ Québec TP7)

La base de données Cour d'Appel du Bas-Canada comprend la description de 829 dossiers produits entre 1772 et 1835, mais principalement entre 1777 et 1816. De la Conquête à 1777, seulement huit dossiers ont été conservés et 88 pour la période allant de 1817 à 1835.

La base de données touche toute la province de Québec puis tout le Bas-Canada créé en vertu de l'Acte constitutionnel de 1791. Les informations sur tous les dossiers conservés des cours d'appel produits avant 1849 s'y retrouvent. Ces dossiers sont conservés par BANQ Québec, sous la cote TP7 (Contenants 1980-09-031/1 à 19). Tous les dossiers conservés ont été décrits dans la base de données qui résulte de la fusion de deux instruments de recherche : 301972 et 301554. L'instrument de recherche 301972 décrivait les dossiers de la Cour d'appel dont le classement est numérique et chronologique. Les dossiers mentionnés dans cet instrument de recherche n'étaient pas numérotés. La numérotation qu'ils portent leur a été donnée par les Archives nationales du Québec. Les dossiers 1 à 137 se sont vu attribuer une numérotation alpha-numérique (lettre B) pour les distinguer de ceux des années 1772-1793 (Contenants 1980-09-031/1 à 8) portant déjà ces numéros et décrits dans l'instrument de recherche 301554. Des dossiers de la Cour d'appel pour les années 1777 à 1815 (Contenant 1960-01-352/352) avaient été oubliés. Leur découverte a fait en sorte que quelques-uns des dossiers portant la numérotation B ont pu ainsi être rattachés à d'autres déjà mentionnés dans l'instrument de recherche 301554. Cela explique l'élimination de certaines causes numérotées B. Cependant, parmi les pièces retrouvées, certaines n'ont pu être intégrées à des dossiers déjà numérotés : nous leur avons attribué les numéros 662 et suivants et les avons classés le contenant 1980-09-031/18.

Index of dossiers of the Court of Appeals of Lower Canada

1772-1835

Originally, the English government wanted to provide its new colony with a simple administration of justice modeled on English structures. From 1764 to 1774, the governor and his council formed the court of appeal. This was followed by the Provisional Court of Appeal in 1776, the Court of Appeal in 1777 and then the Provincial Court of Appeal or Superior Court of Civil Jurisdiction from 1793 until 1843. The court then sat only in Quebec. The Provincial Court of Appeal was repealed in 1843 and replaced the same year by the Court of Appeal for Lower Canada (7 Vict., c. 18) which had jurisdiction over civil and criminal cases. From now on, three sessions will be held alternately in Quebec and Montreal. The courts of appeal of this period heard mainly civil disputes whose amounts in question exceeded 10 pounds sterling (from 1777 to 1792) or 20 pounds sterling (from 1793 to 1849). Few criminal cases are there,

because no automatic right of appeal existed in criminal law at the time. Between 1764 and 1849, the Courts of Appeal constituted the final court of appeal for all civil and criminal cases in Lower Canada, except for the possibility of appeal to the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council in London for cases over 500 louis.

The Index of Records of the Court of Appeal for Lower Canada, 1772-1835 (BAnQ Québec TP7) The Court of Appeal of Lower Canada database includes the description of 829 files produced between 1772 and 1835, but mainly between 1777 and 1816. From the Conquest to 1777, only eight files have been kept and 88 for the period from 1817 to 1835. The database covers the entire province of Québec and then all of Lower Canada, created under the Constitutional Act of 1791. Information on all files kept from the courts of appeal produced before 1849 can be found there. These files are kept by BAnQ Québec, under the symbol TP7 (Containers 1980-09-031/1 to 19). All of the preserved files were described in the database resulting from the merger of two finding aids: 301972 and 301554. Finding aid 301972 described the Court of Appeal files whose classification is numerical and chronological. The files mentioned in this finding aid were not numbered. The numbering they bear was given to them by the Archives nationales du Québec. Files 1 to 137 have been assigned an alpha-numeric numbering (letter B) to distinguish them from those of the years 1772-1793 (Containers 1980-09-031/1 to 8) already bearing these numbers and described in the instrument 301554. Court of Appeal records for the years 1777 to 1815 (Container 1960-01-352/352) had been overlooked. Their discovery meant that some of the files bearing the number B could thus be attached to others already mentioned in the finding aid 301554. This explains the elimination of certain cases numbered B. On the other hand, among the pieces found, some could not be integrated into already numbered files: we assigned them the numbers 662 and following and classified them as 1980-09-031/18

Archives nationales à Québec - Les cours d'appel de cette époque porte Numéro : 30197, 273 pages principalement sur des litiges civils dont les montants en cause excédaient 10 livres sterling (de 1777 à 1792) ou 20 livres sterling (de 1793 à 1849). Peu de causes criminelles s'y trouvent, car aucun droit d'appel automatique n'existait en droit criminel à l'époque.

Archives nationales du Québec – The Courts of Appeal of this period, number 30,197 dossiers, 273 pages mainly on civil disputes whose amounts in dispute exceeded 10 pounds sterling (from 1793 to 1849). Few criminal cases are there, because no automatic right of appeal existed in criminal law at the time.

Fonds Cour des plaideurs communs du

district de Montréal

1777-1794

En 1777, l'ordonnance 17 Georges III c. 1 a établi une cour des plaideurs communs dans les districts de Québec et de Montréal pour entendre toutes les causes civiles de quelque valeur que ce soit. Tenant compte de la restauration du droit canadien par l'Acte de Québec en 1774, cette ordonnance attribue à ces tribunaux, par contraste avec leurs prédécesseurs, l'exclusivité de la juridiction civile de première instance, puisque la Cour du banc du roi est restreinte, par une

autre ordonnance de la même année (17 Georges III c. 5), à la juridiction criminelle. La Cour des plaidoyers communs du district de Montréal doit siéger au moins un jour par semaine, habituellement le vendredi, pour les litiges n'excédant pas 10 livres sterling et un autre jour pour les affaires excédant ce montant. Ce tribunal reçoit aussi la compétence de juger des affaires civiles inférieures ailleurs qu'à son siège principal, pendant des « circuits » ou « tournées » que ses juges doivent accomplir deux fois par an. Les justiciables peuvent en appeler de ses décisions à la cour d'appel formée par le Gouverneur et son Conseil pour des montants excédant 10 livres sterling ou impliquant des droits futurs. En 1794, une nouvelle loi sur la judicature abolit la Cour des plaidoyers communs du district de Montréal en la remplaçant par la Cour du banc du roi pour le district de Montréal qui va cumuler les compétences civile et criminelle.

Court of Common Pleas in the districts of Quebec and Montreal 1777-1794

In 1777, ordinance 17 Georges III c. 1 has established a court of common pleas in the districts of Quebec and Montreal to hear all civil cases of whatever value. Taking into account the restoration of Canadian law by the Quebec Act of 1774, this ordinance attributes to these courts, in contrast to their predecessors, the exclusive civil jurisdiction of the first instance, since the Court of King's Bench is restricted, by another ordinance of the same year (17 Georges III c. 5), to the criminal jurisdiction. The Court of Common Pleas for the District of Montreal must sit at least one day a week, usually Friday, for disputes not exceeding £10 and another day for cases exceeding this amount. This court also receives jurisdiction to judge lower civil cases elsewhere than at its main seat, during “circuits” or “tours” that its judges must perform twice a year. Litigants may appeal its decisions to the Court of Appeal formed by the Governor and his Council for amounts exceeding £10 or involving future rights. In 1794, a new law on the judicature abolished the Court of Common Pleas for the District of Montreal, replacing it with the Court of King's Bench for the District of Montreal, which would combine civil and criminal jurisdiction.

Index des dossiers de la Cour des plaidoyers communs du district de Québec, Matières civiles en général

1777-1794

La base de données

Index des dossiers de la Cour des plaidoyers communs du district de Québec, Matières civiles en général (TL15,S2) a été bâtie à partir des informations provenant de fichiers produits par le palais de justice de Québec. Ces fichiers ont été mis sur microfiches par les Archives nationales du Québec (30149 et 301547). Elles touchent les cours des plaidoyers communs du district de Québec, la Cour du Banc du roi/de la reine pour le district de Québec et la Cour supérieure du district de Québec et couvrent la période allant de 1765 à 1899. Monsieur Guy Gagnon, bénévolement, en a patiemment saisi le contenu sur Excel. Un travail considérable qui s'est échelonné sur une période de deux ans et demi (223 000 entrées).

Le personnel des Archives nationales du Québec a ensuite entrepris un travail minutieux d'élimination des doublons et de bonification des informations. Pour la Cour des plaidoyers communs du district de Québec (TL15,S2), les 3 319 entrées conservées, représentant environ 6 600 individus, ont été complétées à partir des informations contenues dans les doublons lorsqu'ils étaient plus complets. Par exemple, les prénoms au long. Nous avons mis entre parenthèses des variantes des patronymes afin de faciliter la recherche. Par exemple : Perrault (Perreault, Peraut, Perreau, Perreaut, Perraut, Perrot, Perot, Perrau, Perauts, Perro, Péraux, Pero), etc. La base de données touche les dossiers numérotés de 1670 à 3953, soit 2 283 causes entendues entre 1777 et 1794.

Les fiches avaient été doublées permettant ainsi de rechercher tant par le nom du demandeur que par celui du défendeur. Toutefois, après informatisation et tri selon les numéros de causes, des lacunes sont rapidement apparues : fiches disparues ou incomplètes, erreurs de transcription. Bref, 9 % des fiches étaient manquantes et un plus grand nombre encore comportaient des informations incomplètes, mais, grâce aux doublons, nous avons pu reconstituer un fichier beaucoup plus fiable.

Les dossiers identifiés A à Z ((1980-09-008/55 et 56) et les documents épars et fragmentaires (1980-09-008/75) ne sont pas inclus dans la base de données.

Signalons qu'aucun dossier n'a été conservé pour la Juridiction inférieure de la Cour des plaidoyers communs (Affaires de moins de 10 livres Sterling) ou pour la Cour en tournée. Les registres ont cependant été conservés pour la juridiction

inférieure (TL15,S3) et pour la Cour en tournée (TL15,S19) et sont disponibles en ligne.

Index of files of the Court of Common Pleas of the District of Quebec, Civil matters in general

1777-1794

The database

The Index of files of the Court of Common Pleas of the District of Quebec database, Civil matters in general (TL15,S2) was built from information from files produced by the Quebec courthouse. These files were put on microfiche by the National Archives of Québec (30149 and 301547). They concern the courts of common pleas of the district of Québec, the Court of King's/Queen's Bench for the district of Québec and the Superior Court of the district of Québec and cover the period from 1765 to 1899 (223,000 admissions). The personnel of the National Archives of Quebec then undertook a meticulous work of eliminating duplicates and improving information. For the Court of Common Pleas for the District of Quebec (TL15,S2), the 3,319 preserved entries, representing approximately 6,600 individuals, were supplemented from information contained in the duplicates when they were more complete. For example, long first names. We have put variant surnames in parentheses in order to facilitate the search. For example: Perrault (Perreault, Peraut, Perreau, Perreaut, Perraut, Perrot, Perot, Perrau, Perauts, Perro, Peraux, Pero), etc. The database covers cases numbered from 1670 to 3953, i.e. 2,283 cases heard between 1777 and 1794. The files had been duplicated, thus making it possible to search both by the name of the plaintiff and that of the defendant. However, after computerization and sorting according to case numbers, shortcomings quickly appeared: missing or incomplete records, transcription errors. In short, 9% of the files were missing and an even greater number contained incomplete information, but, thanks to the duplicates, we were able to reconstitute a much more reliable file. Files identified A to Z ((1980-09-008/55 and 56) and scattered and fragmentary documents (1980-09-008/75) are not included in the database. Note that no records were kept for the Lower Court of the Court of Common Pleas (Cases under £10) or for the Court on Tour. The registers have, however, been kept for the Lower Court (TL15,S3) and for the Court on tour (TL15,S19) and are available online.

Les fiches avaient été doublées permettant ainsi de rechercher tant par le nom du demandeur que par celui du défendeur. Toutefois, après informatisation et tri selon les numéros de cause, des lacunes sont rapidement apparues : fiches disparues ou incomplètes, erreurs de transcription. Bref, environ 10 % des fiches étaient manquantes et un plus grand nombre encore comportaient des informations incomplètes. Grâce aux doublons, nous avons pu reconstituer un fichier beaucoup plus fiable.

Le personnel des Archives nationales du Québec a entrepris un travail minutieux d'élimination des doublons et de bonification des informations. Pour la période allant de 1849 à 1878, objet de la présente base de données, nous avons au départ 54 542 entrées, dont 23 521 doublons. Les 30 530 entrées conservées, représentant environ 30 000 individus, ont été complétées à partir des informations contenues dans les doublons lorsqu'ils étaient plus complets. The Index of records database of the Superior Court, district of Quebec, Civil matters in general (TP11, S1, SS2), 1849-1878 collection was built from a file produced by the Quebec courthouse. The information came from the Superior Court dockets. The file was put on microfiche by the National Archives of Quebec (301547). It covers the period from 1849 to 1899. Mr. Guy Gagnon, on a voluntary basis, patiently entered the content into Excel. The files had been duplicated, thus making it possible to search both by the name of the plaintiff and that of the defendant. However, after computerization and sorting according to case numbers, shortcomings quickly appeared: missing or incomplete records, transcription errors. In short, about 10% of the cards were missing and an even greater number contained incomplete information. Thanks to the duplicates, we were able to reconstruct a much more reliable file. The staff of the Archives Nationales du Québec has undertaken meticulous work to eliminate duplicates and improve information. For the period from 1849 to 1878, the subject of this database, we initially had 54,542 entries, including 23,521 duplicates. The 30,530 preserved entries, representing approximately 30,000 individuals, were supplemented from information contained in the duplicates when they were more complete. For example, full names and surnames. The information on microfiche being often difficult to read, we used the “or” when it was difficult to decide: Alain or Allaire; Fortier or Fortin, Auger or Angers. Similarly, when spelling variations of surnames were encountered, we put the variant(s) in parentheses in order to facilitate the search. For example: Perreault (Perrault); etc

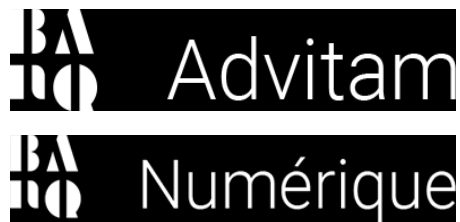
